SUBJECT: Motor Vehicle Collision Report

State Fleet Services experienced a total of 407 reported motor vehicle collisions from July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009.

The most frequent type of crash continues to be backing. 30 percent of State Fleet collisions during this period were caused by improper backing. Unrecovered collision repair cost is a factor in establishing rental rates for State Fleet vehicles. Backing collisions are almost always preventable.

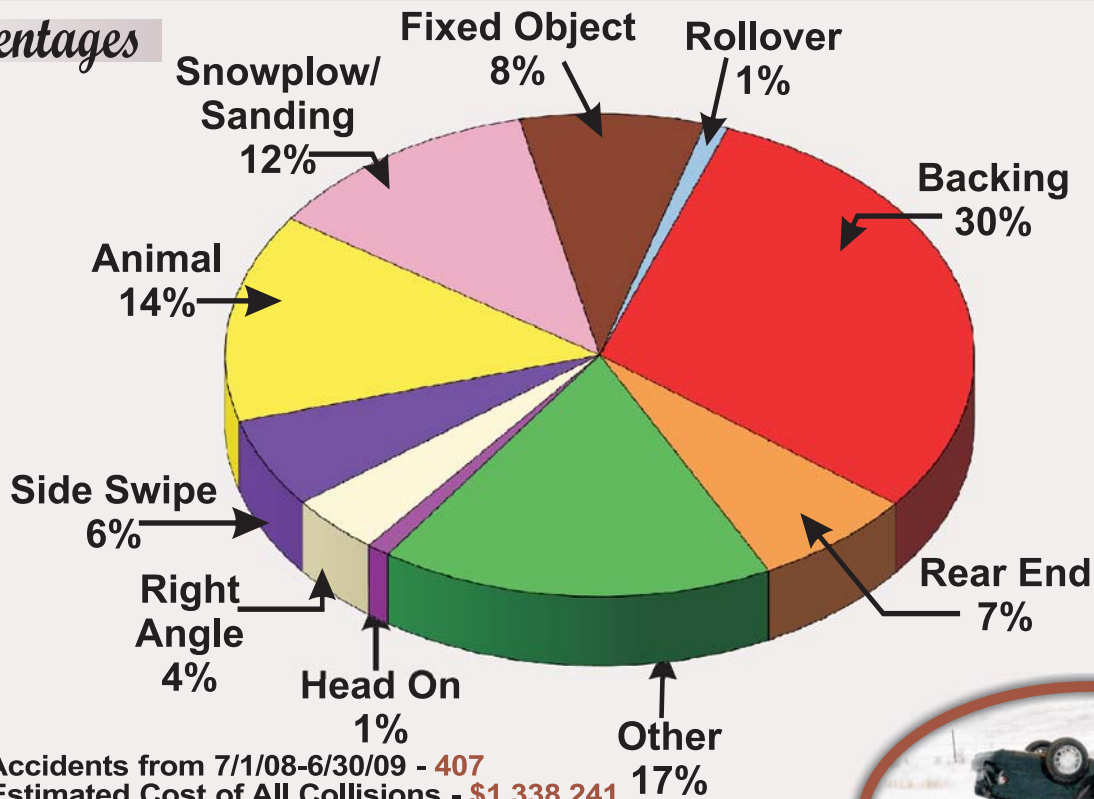
Safe driving is everyone's concern. No one is immune from a crash. The attached charts and graphs represent the data visually. Please share it with your entire staff.

Collision By Type

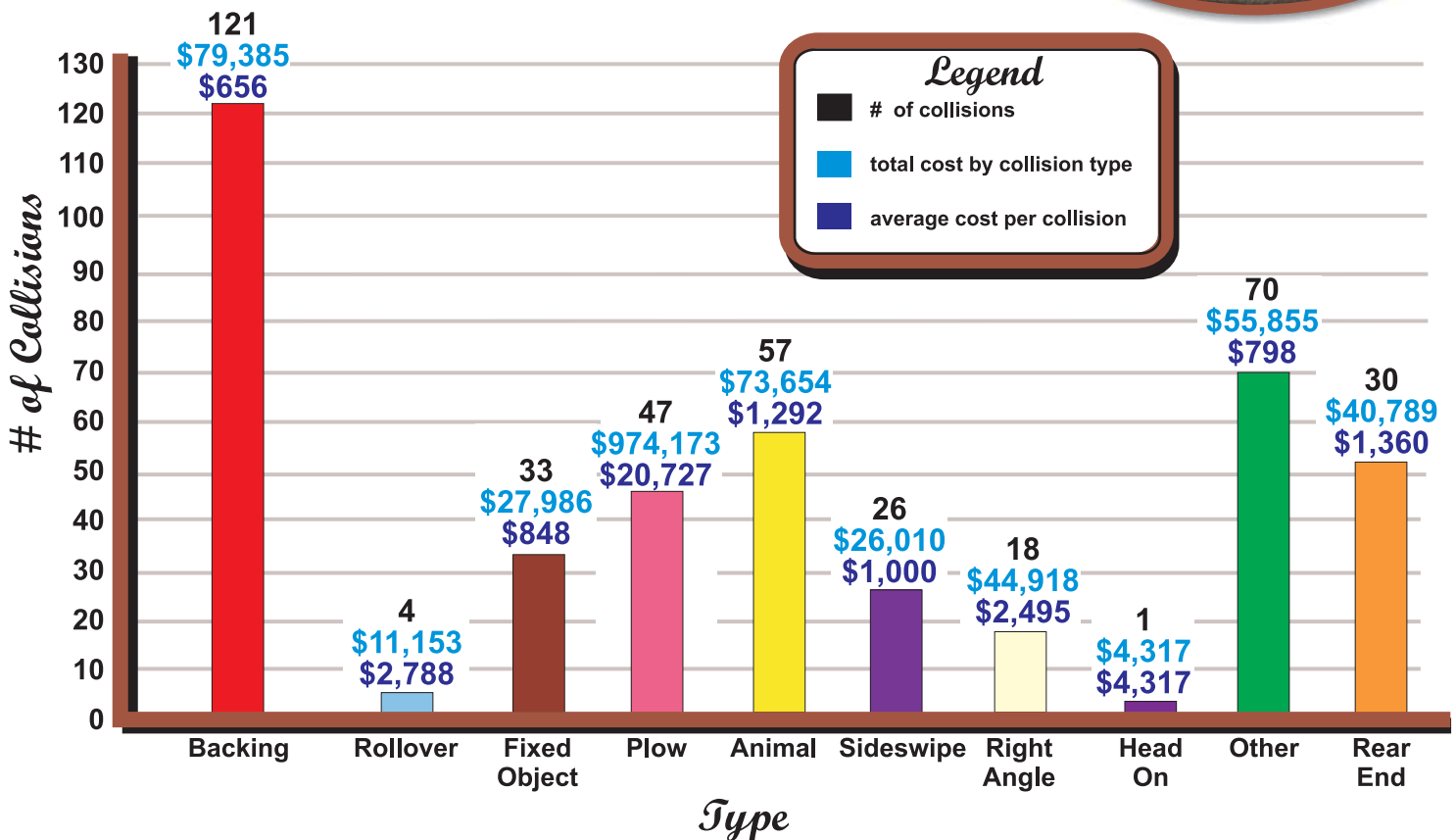

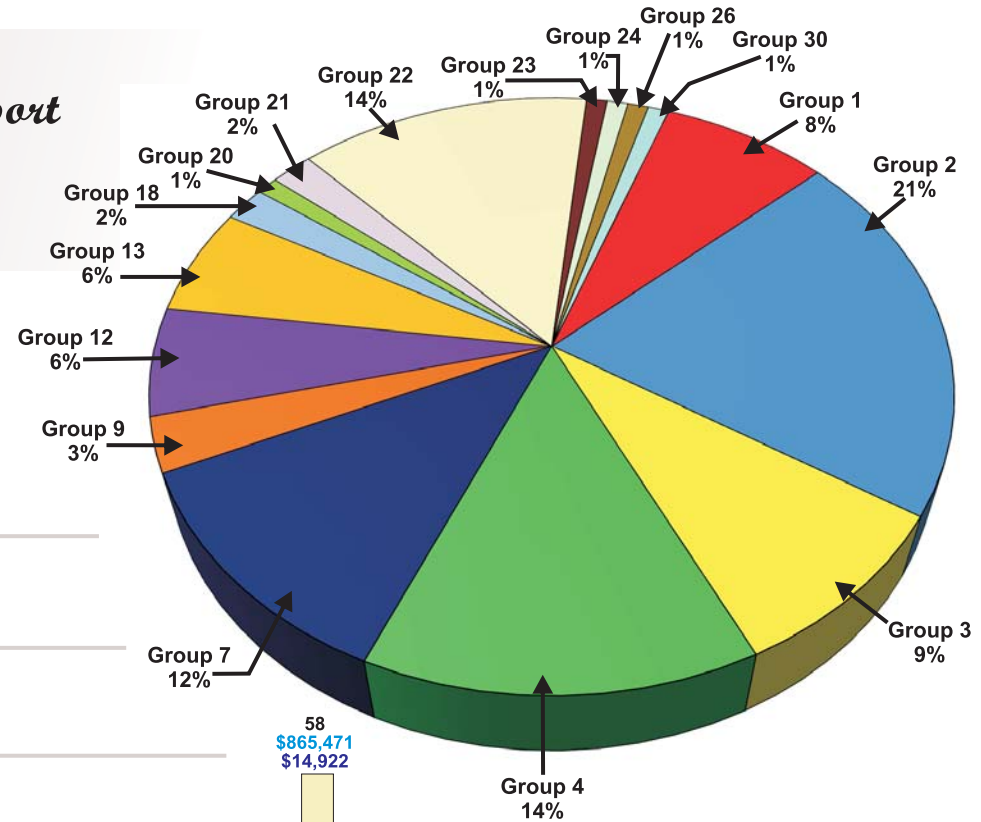
Total Accidents from 7/1/08-6/30/09 - 407

 Average Cost per Collision - \$3,288



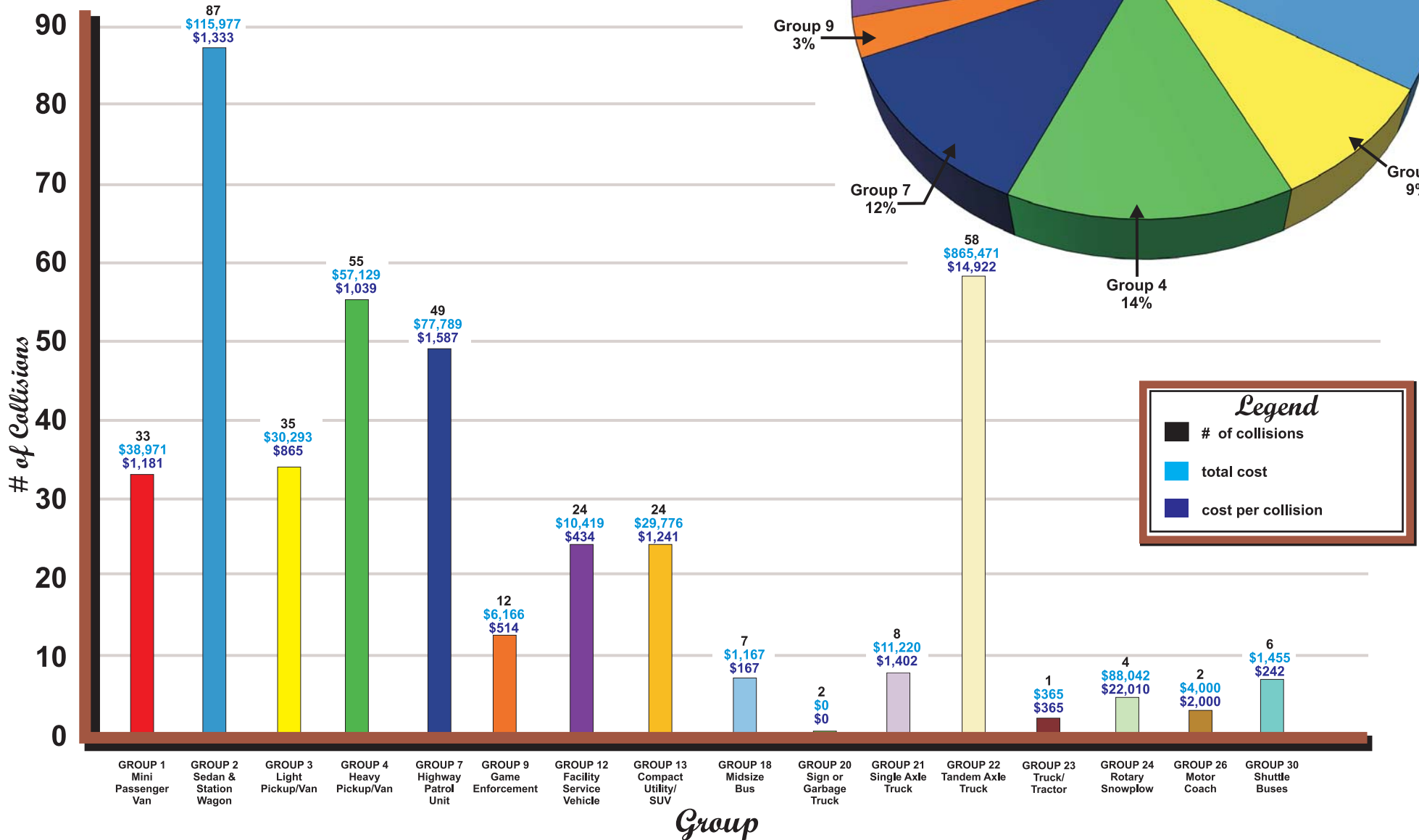
Total Cost by Collision Type
