Public Information Meeting to be held on November 17 to discuss Proposed Improvements to ND Highway 11 in Fairmount

A Public Information Meeting will be held from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. on November 17, 2009, at the Fairmount Community Center. The Public Information Meeting will utilize an open house format.

The purpose of the Public Information Meeting is to discuss the proposed improvements to ND Highway 11 in the city of Fairmount. The project consists of reconstruction from west of Front Street to east of 3rd Street, and a mill and overlay from east of 3rd Street to 6th Street. The reconstruction portion of the project will improve the subgrade of the existing roadway, provide an improved pavement surface and profile, and upgrade the underground storm sewer. The mill and overlay portion of the project will improve the ride quality of the existing roadway.

The Public Information Meeting will provide opportunity for the public to ask questions. Representatives from the North Dakota Department of Transportation will be available to address questions and/or concerns.
