Public Hearing to be held on April 3 to discuss proposed improvements to East Divide Avenue in Bismarck

A Public Hearing will be held from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. on Tuesday, April 3, 2012 at the City of Bismarck Public Works Building, 601 South 26th Street. The Public Hearing will utilize an open house format with a formal presentation at 6:00 p.m.

The purpose of the Public Hearing is to discuss proposed improvements for East Divide Avenue, beginning at 26th Street North and extending to East Bismarck Expressway. The Public Hearing will provide opportunity for public input. Representatives from the City of Bismarck, North Dakota Department of Transportation and Kadrmass, Lee & Jackson will be available to answer questions.
