## Travel Alert issued for Interstate 94 from the Montana border to Hebron

The North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) and the North Dakota Highway Patrol (NDHP) have issued a **Travel Alert** for Interstate 94 in southwestern North Dakota from the Montana border to Hebron due to icy roads causing difficult travel. Areas included in the **Travel Alert** are the cities of Beach, Medora, Belfield, Dickinson, Hebron and surrounding areas along I-94.

A **Travel Alert** means conditions are such that **motorists can still travel** in these areas, but should be advised of rapidly changing conditions. Motorists are encouraged to reduce speeds and drive according to the conditions.

All travelers are encouraged to monitor road conditions as weather conditions occur and use caution while traveling. For road information, call 511 from any type of phone or go to the website: [www.dot.nd.gov](http://www.dot.nd.gov).

The NDDOT works hard to keep travelers informed of road conditions. However, the road conditions are not reported 24 hours a day but updated every day from 5 a.m. to 10 p.m. Central Time, including holidays. It's important to remember that the conditions may vary from what is being reported.
