Construction begins July 11 on Southbound Interstate 29 near Pembina

Construction begins Monday, July 11, on Southbound Interstate 29 near Pembina. Work will consist of painting the Southbound bridge that spans the Pembina River along Interstate 29.

During construction:

- Speeds will be reduced to 55 mph through work area
- A width restriction of 15 feet will be in place
- Flaggers may be present
- Motorists may experience minimal delays
- Concrete jersey barriers will close off the right lane.

The project is expected to be complete at the end of July, weather permitting.
