Disadvantaged Business Enterprise: Program Implementation Modifications

FINAL RULE

49 CFR Part 26



USDOT Posts 2014 DBE Final Rule – Becomes effective November 3, 2014.

The US Department of Transportation has issued a final rule amending its disadvantaged business enterprise (DBE) program at 49 CFR Part 26. The Department’s 2014 final rule contains important improvements to the DBE program regulations. The Final Rule and a fact sheet highlighting the major changes are available for viewing at the USDOT Office of Civil Rights web location:

The rule becomes effective November 3, 2014.

NDDOT will roll out changes before the February Bid Opening.

NEW SPECIFICATIONS FOR ROAD AND BRIDGE BUILDING APPLY TO ALL FY2015 PROJECTS

On October 1, 2014, the Department adopted its new 2014 Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction. Years in the making, the new specifications represent a major rewrite of the Department's rules and regulations as they apply to road and bridge construction.

The new Specifications apply to all projects let to bid after October 1, 2014. The previous version, 2008 Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, applies to any projects let to bid prior to October 1, 2014.

Be sure to review the new specifications to determine whether there are changes you'll need to make in your work product. It is your responsibility to review the new specifications and note any changes which apply to any work they intend to perform.

Hard copies of the 2014 Standard Specifications are not currently available. Ordering information and cost have not been determined at this time. We anticipate that ordering will be available around January 1, 2015. The electronic file is available on the Department's website at <http://www.dot.nd.gov/dotnet/supplspecs/standardspecs.aspx>

DBEs will receive a free copy of the 2014 Specifications when the hard copies become available.

HOW TO PROTECT ROADWORKERS FROM HEARING LOSS

Different levels of noise are all around crewmembers every day on jobsites. However, whenever workers are exposed to some of those sounds for hours on end every day, hearing loss can become a serious problem.

Approximately 22 million Americans are exposed to noise levels loud enough to damage hearing every year, according to the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health. In fact, 4 million workers go to work each day with damaging noise, and 10 million people in the U.S. have a noise-related hearing loss.

For safety, NIOSH recommends that workers should not be exposed to noise levels that amount to more than 85 decibels for eight hours. The organization put together a Noise Meter to help show how many decibels certain pieces of equipment put out. 
