Work on Interstate 94 begins 3 miles east of the Oriska Interchange

Beginning this week, crews will be working on culverts under the I-94 roadway three miles east of the Oriska Interchange.

During construction:

- Speeds will be reduced to 55 mph
- One lane closure will be in place east bound direction
- One lane closure will be in place west bound direction
- 15-foot width restrictions will be in place

The project is expected to take approximately two months.
