Temporary detour on ND Highway 23 east of Watford City provided for motorists beginning this week for bypass work

Starting this week, motorists traveling on ND Highway 23 will be detoured onto a temporary paved roadway about one mile east of Watford City. The 1.5 mile temporary detour is located near the highway which is under construction. This is part of the Southeast Watford City Bypass project and is expected to be complete this fall.

During construction:

- Speeds will be reduced to 25 mph
- Traffic will be detoured

The detour route will be in place during construction of the bypass.
