Construction begins Monday, August 18, on ND Highway 66 near Bisbee, 9 miles west of US Highway 281

Construction begins Monday, August 18, on ND Highway 66 near Bisbee, nine miles west of US Highway 281. Work will consist of replacing a box culvert and widening the roadway.

During construction:

- Speeds will be reduced to 25 mph through work area
- A width restriction of 12 feet will be in place
- Flagger may be present
- Pilot cars will be present when required
- Motorists may experience 5-10 minutes delays

Traffic will be shifted onto a temporary roadway with a gravel surface.

The project is expected to be complete at the end of September, weather permitting.
