Speeds to be reduced on Williston Temporary Truck Reliever Route from 140th Ave NW to 143rd Ave NW next week

Beginning on Tuesday, September 2nd, speeds will be temporarily reduced to 25 mph on the Williston Temporary Truck Reliever Route from 140th Avenue Northwest to 143rd Avenue Northwest to allow construction equipment to enter and exit the roadway. Construction equipment will also be entering and exiting the roadway on US Highway 2 between 60th Street Northwest and 62nd Street Northwest. The 25 mph speed restriction and equipment advisory will be in place until October. This work is part of the permanent Williston Truck Reliever Route.

During construction:

- Motorists should expect delays
- Flaggers will be in place
- Motorists are advised to watch for trucks exiting and entering the roadway
- Speeds reduced to 25 mph
