Traffic will be reduced to one lane on Friday and Sunday at intersection of ND Highway 1804 and Dakota Drive in New Town

Traffic will be reduced to one lane on Friday, September 26th and Sunday, September 28th for paving work from the intersection of ND Highway 1804 and Dakota Drive in New Town to north of the intersection from 3 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Friday. Flaggers will be in place to direct traffic and motorists will take turns traveling through the area.

On Sunday from 7.a.m to 5 p.m., intersection work will resume and traffic will be reduced to one lane. Flaggers will be in place to direct traffic and motorists will take turns traveling through the area.

This project includes reconstruction of this intersection, paving, new intersection signals and an additional center turn lane on ND Highway 1804.

During construction:

- Speeds will be reduced to 25 mph
- Motorists should expect delays
- Flaggers will be present to direct traffic
- Traffic will be reduced to one lane and flaggers will be in place to direct traffic
