Testing of new LED lights taking place today on Sorlie Bridge in Grand Forks

Testing of new color changing LED lights will take place today, December 17 at 5 p.m. on the Sorlie Bridge in Grand Forks/East Grand Forks. Traffic will not be affected by the testing of the LED lights.

A committee consisting of the Cities of Grand Forks and East Grand Forks, the North Dakota Department of Transportation, the Minnesota Department of Transportation, the Grand Forks Historic Preservation Commission, the North Dakota State Historic Preservation Office and the Minnesota State Historic Preservation Office, will decide how and when the color changing LED lights will be used on the bridge in the future.

The LED lights were installed during a recent rehabilitation project on the Sorlie Bridge.
