Public Input Meeting January 26, to discuss proposed improvements to westbound SE Jamestown Interchange (Exit 260) Bridge

A Public Input Meeting will be held from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. on January 26, 2016 at the Gladstone Inn & Suites at 111 2nd St NE, Jamestown, ND. The Public Input Meeting will utilize an open house format with a formal presentation at 5:15 p.m.

The purpose of the Public Input Meeting is to discuss proposed improvements and detour routes for the SE Jamestown Interchange (Exit 260) Westbound Bridge, located on I-94 at mile 260.125. The project consists of replacing the existing structure. The Public Input Meeting will provide opportunity for public input. Representatives from the ND Department of Transportation will be on hand to answer questions and discuss concerns.
