## **Public Input Meeting on January 28, to discuss proposed improvements to westbound US Highway 2 at Surrey**

A Public Input Meeting will be held from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. on January 28, 2016 at the Surrey City Hall. The Public Input Meeting will utilize an open house format.

The purpose of the Public Input Meeting is to discuss proposed improvements for the westbound BNSF grade separation (overpass), located on US 2 at mile 154.989. The project consists of replacing the existing structure and the partial re-grading of the approach roadways. Traffic will be maintained through the use of median crossovers and two-way traffic on the eastbound roadway. This meeting will provide opportunity for public input. Representatives from the ND Department of Transportation will be on hand to answer questions and discuss concerns.
