Public Information Meeting July 21, to discuss proposed improvements to ND Hwy. 200 from the east Jct. of ND 41 to the west Jct. of US 52

A Public Information Meeting will be held from 5:00 to 7:00 p.m. on July 21, 2016, at the McClusky City Hall located at 117 Ave B N, McClusky, ND. The meeting will utilize an open house format.

The purpose of the Public Information Meeting is to discuss proposed improvements for ND 200 and ND 3 from the east junction of ND 41 east to the west junction of US 52. Proposed improvements are to take place near Mercer, McClusky, Goodrich, Hurdsfield, and Bowdon. The meeting will provide opportunity for the public to ask questions. Representatives from the North Dakota Department of Transportation will be present for the purposes of the meeting.

The North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) will consider every request for reasonable accommodation to provide:

- an accessible meeting facility or other accommodation for people with disabilities,
- language interpretation for people with limited English proficiency (LEP), and
- translations of written material necessary to access NDDOT programs and information.
