Public Hearing August 15, to discuss proposed improvements to ND Highway 1804 in New Town, ND

A Public Hearing will be held from 5:00 to 7:00 pm on Monday, August 15, 2016, at the New Town City Hall. The hearing will utilize an open house format with a formal presentation at 5:30 pm.

The purpose of the Public Hearing is to discuss the proposed improvements of ND Highway 1804 from the 23B Bypass to Mountrail County Road 5. The hearing will provide opportunity for public input. Staff from the NDDOT and Ulteig Engineers, Inc. will be available to answer questions.
