NDDOT seeks comments on 2016 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) Amendment

The North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) is seeking comments on an amendment to the 2016-2019 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) for inclusion of previously-unpublished projects in 2016 and for the addition of federal funding to a previously-published project in 2016.

1. Asphalt overlay and widening on ND Highway 5 from the state line east to the west junction of US Highway 85 near Fortuna.
Total Cost: \$4,500,000
2. Asphalt overlay on US Highway 85 from the west junction of US Highway 85 near Fortuna north to the state line.
Total Cost: \$3,000,000
