

US HIGHWAY 52 FOUR LANE

WHAT IS THE PROPOSED PROJECT?

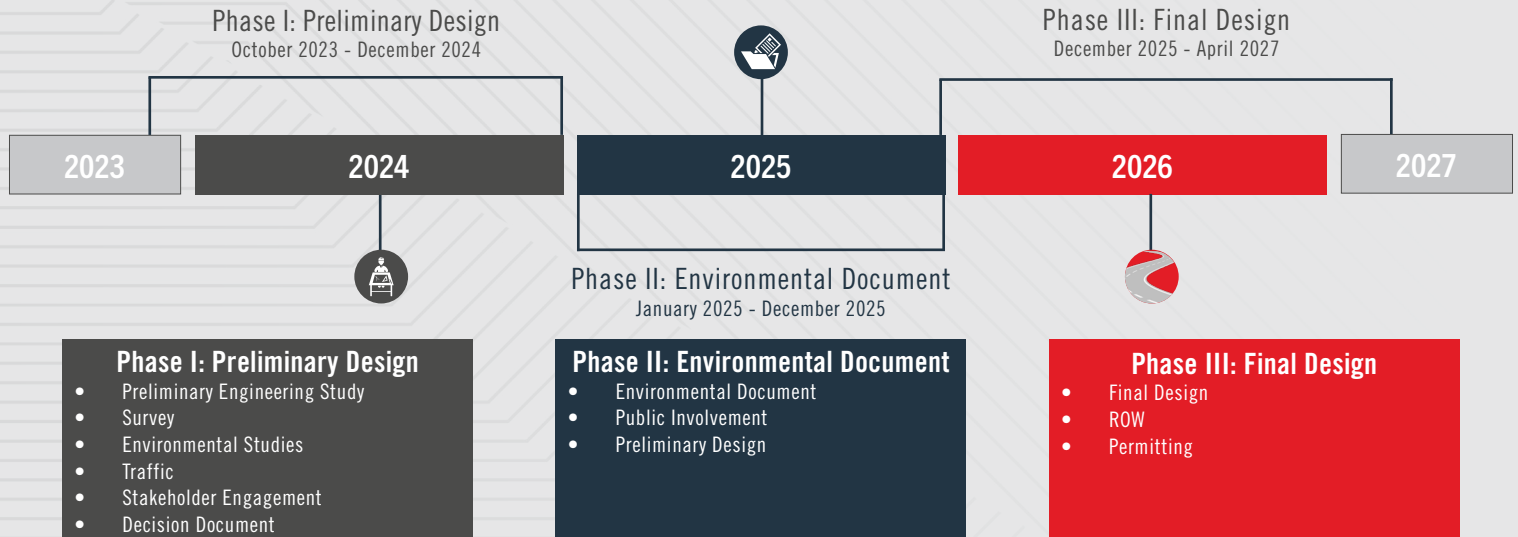
The North Dakota Department of Transportation is studying the expansion of US Highway 52 from a two-lane highway to a four-lane highway between Minot and Voltaire. Two primary build alternatives are being considered: a four-lane highway with depressed median and a four-lane highway with flush median. The project corridor has been broken into six segments to further analyze the alternatives. Please refer to the accompanying map for a visual overview of the project corridor and segment locations.



WHY IS THE PROJECT BEING STUDIED?

During the 2023 legislative session, the North Dakota Legislature allocated funding to study the expansion of US Highway 52 to four lanes between Minot and Voltaire. This funding was part of House Bill 1012, which supports statewide roadway infrastructure improvements. Local lawmakers championed the inclusion of this study in HB 1012, prioritizing the enhancement of safety along this stretch of highway.
