Nominations	The two primary ways an installation can be nominated for a project, through a Military

Nomination Details	A state or community should submit a self-nomination to the Program Activity Lead that may	
	include the following details: Point of Contact; Description of actual/potential compatibility or	
	resilience issue; A description of the proposed project; A description of the anticipated role of	
	the installation(s) in the plan and concurrence with the proposal.
