



- Reestablish the bridge structural integrity
- Increase lifespan of the bridge
- Improve Safety



Project Need


- Original construction 1959
 — Riprap placed in 1983
 — Rail Retrofit in 1993
- Deck exhibits spalling and patching
- Abutment spalling
- Significant undermining of the existing abutments with exposed piling
- Rail Retrofit does not meet design standards
- Outdated Guardrail



Deck Overlay and Rail Retrofit



- Deck Overlay
 - Tie-in to existing roadway off the ends of the bridge
- Rail Retrofit
 - Existing Rail Retrofit does not meet current design standards





Guardrail Replacement



- Guardrail Replacement
 - Existing Guardrail does not meet current design standards





Abutment Repairs



- Erosion and Undermining Repairs
 - Exposed Piling under both abutments
 - Foam Injection
- Spall Repairs






Over-Height Detour Route


