Stay on Top of DBE Requirements During Winter Snowbirding: Even while enjoying the warmer climates, DBE firms must fulfill all obligations, including submitting renewals, answering Q&A/emails, managing utilization plans (UPs), and ensuring prompt payment compliance. Remote access tools can help you stay connected and on track.

Vacationing or Traveling Abroad: If you plan to leave the U.S. or Canada, be aware that access to B2Gnow/CCS will be restricted. Make necessary arrangements beforehand, such as delegating tasks or ensuring compliance work is completed prior to your departure.

Submit Only One Application: To avoid processing delays, please submit only one renewal application.

If you hold both DBE and ACDBE certifications, only one application (either DBE or ACDBE) is required to renew both certifications.

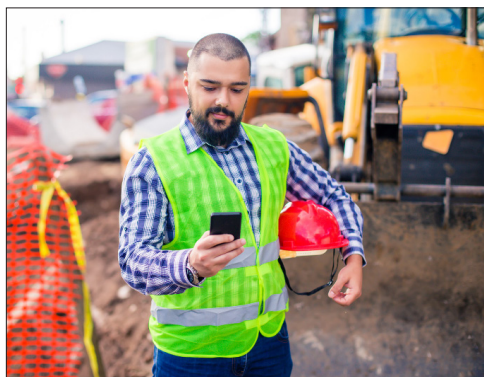


2. Capacity Constraints

NDDOT will also use this information for the electronic haul tickets to better track DBE trucks on site when project personnel may not be present.
