I-94 INTERCHANGE (EXIT 161) RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

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I-94 Exit 161 reconstruction is well underway. Here are some highlights of the progress made over the last month:

- The NE temporary ramp embankment is nearly complete.
- Work has begun on the embankment for the north bridge abutment.
- Geotechnical Instrumentation is installed in the NW and SW bridge abutments embankment areas. This technology will monitor the existing ground on which the embankment is being constructed.
- Work on the south bridge embankment will begin soon.
- Existing high mast lighting has been repositioned to better light the intersection while work is being done.

PLAN FOR DELAYS

Northbound Bismarck Expressway/Centennial Road is reduced to one lane from Miriam Avenue to Trenton Drive (this lane closure will be temporarily removed during the Independence Day holiday). Speeds are reduced across the bridge. Interstate ramps are reduced in width, and shoulder closures may be put in place as needed throughout the next month.

Summer events drawing larger crowds may temporarily impact traffic near the I-94 Exit 161 work zone.
