CONSTRUCTION WORK CONCLUDES FOR 2024 SEASON

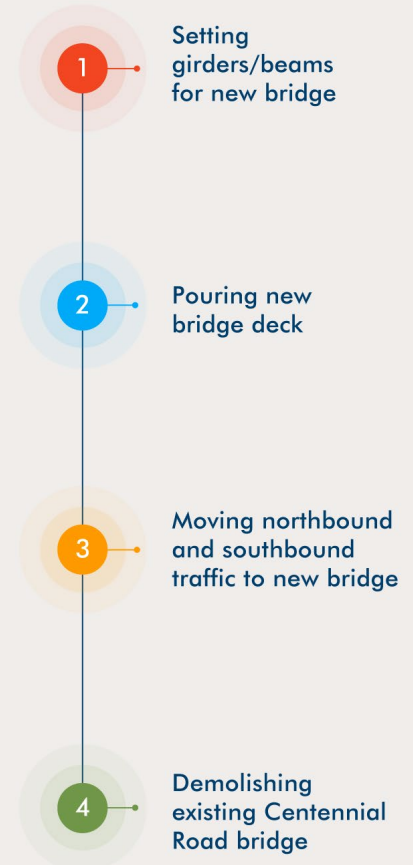
Traffic control and large equipment will be removed at the Interstate 94 Exit 161 reconstruction site by the end of October/early November. Construction is set to resume in Spring 2025, with significant traffic pattern changes. Please be prepared to encounter delays throughout the season.

2024 MILESTONE COMPLETION OVERVIEW

- High mast lighting relocated for improved visibility
- Temporary loop ramps constructed to maintain traffic flow throughout project phases
- NW and SW bridge abutments built to support bridge beams and deck
- Center bridge pier built to support bridge beams and deck
- Mechanically Stabilized Earth (MSE) wall built to support Centennial Road embankment where the right of way is limited



2025 PROJECT TIMELINE
