





# ADA Curb Ramps Bus Stops BisMan Transit - Purple Route

## MULTI-MODAL OPTIONS



Bis-Man Transit provides bus service along Sunset Drive. The purple route provides service daily with stops at Walmart and the Mandan High School.



City of Mandan Parks and Recreation has a shared use path along the east side of Sunset Drive and along the south side of Old Red Trail.



City of Mandan also has sidewalk facilities north and south of the interchange to serve pedestrians in the area.

Level of Service - 2045 No Build














## BOUNDARY STREET

# OLD RED TRAIL OPTION 1A

## Signalized Intersection


Right-of-Way:

Permanent 0.106 Acres

Temporary 0.088 Acres

Estimated Cost: \$46.8 Million





# OLD RED TRAIL OPTION 1B

## Roundabout


Right-of-Way:

Permanent 0.042 Acres
Temporary 0.150 Acres

Estimated Cost: \$47.1Million Additional \$300K for roundabout option.







- All roadways remain open to traffic in current pattern.
- I-94 (one lane each direction) to build crossovers.
- Pedestrian access to be maintained during construction.

### **ANTICIPATED IMPACTS**


- Short term impacts to vehicular and pedestrian traffic during work hours.
- Temporary widenings and bypass to will be constructed using lane shifts and short-term closures.



- I-94 (one lane each direction).
- Sunset Drive maintained on existing roadway.
- Temporary widenings and bypass to maintain trafiic.
- Pedestrian access to be maintained during construction when possible.

#### ANTICIPATED IMPACTS


- Temporary night-time closures on Sunset Drive for bridge demolition and construction (Roadway and Trail)
- Closure of Trail between Old Red Trail and 27th Street for wall construction.
- Reroute of Old Red Trail eastbound traffic and the WB 94 On-Ramp.



- I-94 (one lane each direction).
- Sunset Drive maintained on existing roadway, then shifted to proposed southbound roadway.
- Old Red Trail Intersection fully open to traffic
- Pedestrian access to be maintained during construction when possible.

#### ANTICIPATED IMPACTS

Temporary night-time closures for Bridge demolition and construction on Sunset Drive (Roadway and Trail)



- I-94 Ramps to be constructed.
- Sunset Drive maintained on proposed southbound roadway.
- Old Red Trail Intersection fully open to traffic
- Pedestrian access to be maintained during construction when possible.

### ANTICIPATED IMPACTS

Ramps maintained on temporary bypasses
