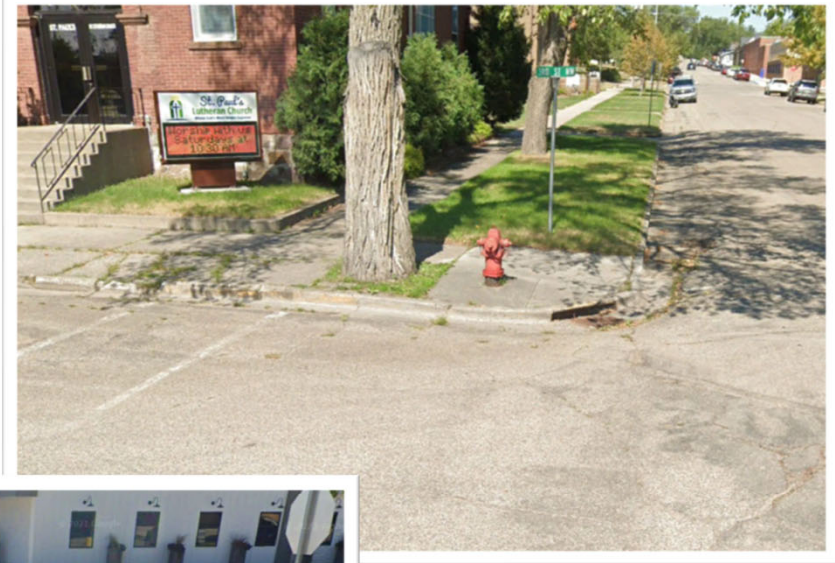
Project History - Pavement

 - » 2002 – Mill & Overlay
- » 3rd St NW
 - » 1979 - Overlay
- » 4th St N
 - » 1979 – Overlay
 - » 2002 – Mill & Overlay
- » 2016 Urban Transportation Needs Study
 - » Fair to Poor Condition



Existing Roadway

- » Varying Roadway Widths from 40' to 56' Curb to Curb

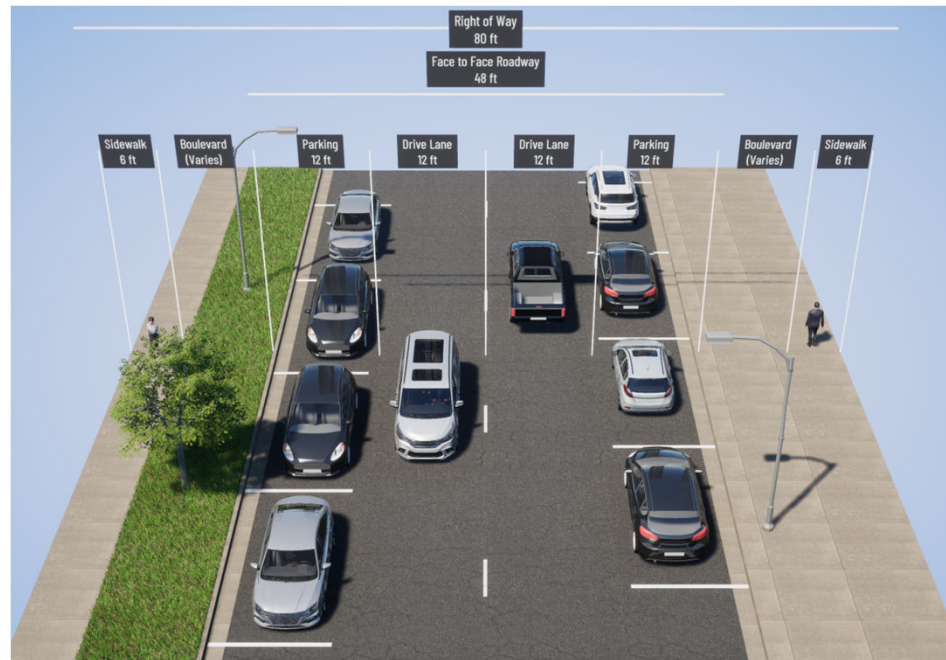

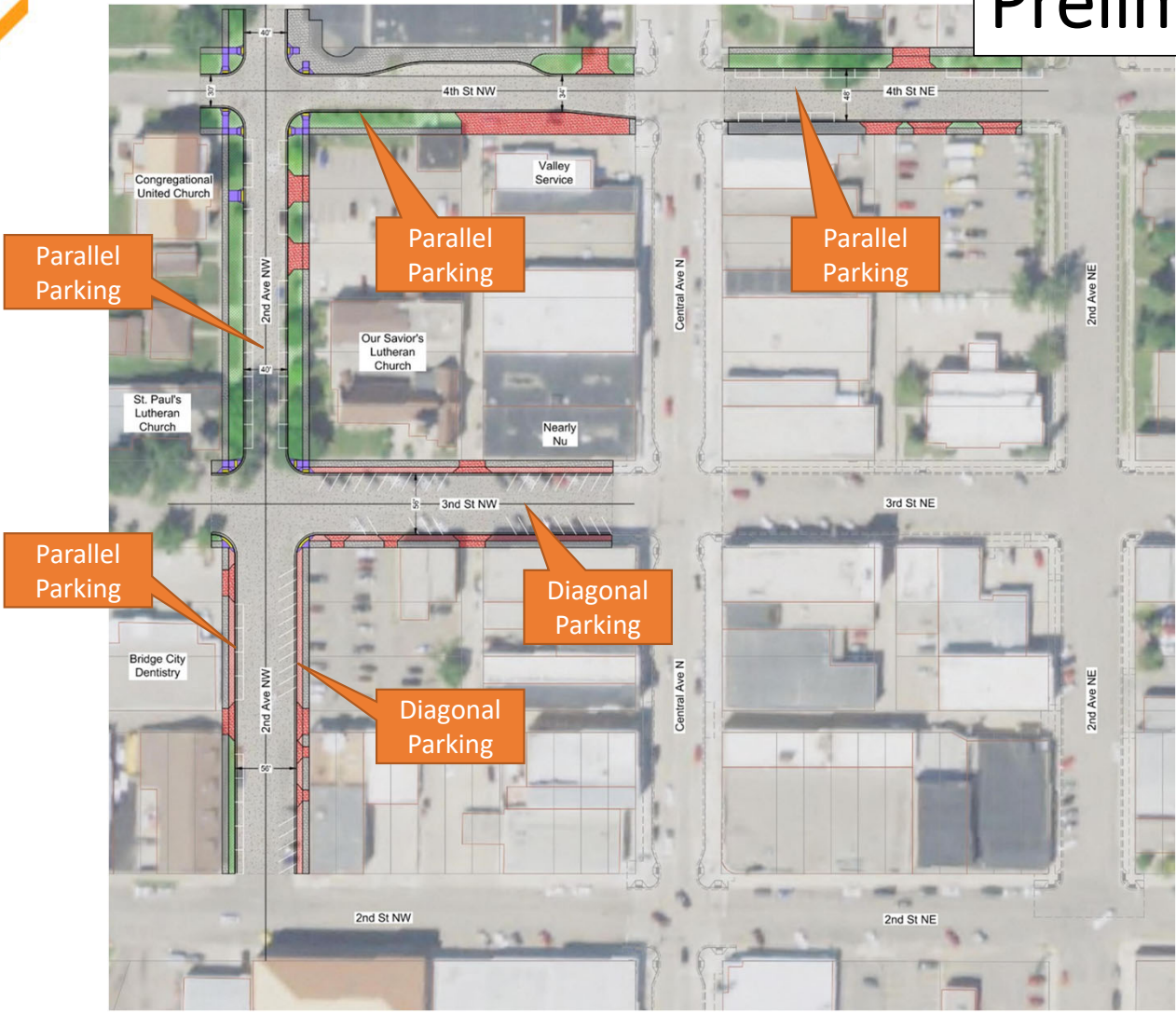


» 4th St NE

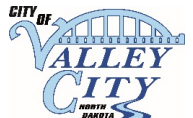
- » Preliminary Opinion of Cost : \$4.50 Million

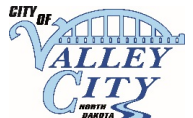
