


Project Location



Existing Site Layout






Purpose of Project

- Mitigate instability from landslide activity on the north side of Main Avenue
- Repair damage that has occurred to the roadway, sidewalk, and utilities
- Protect NDDOT and City of West Fargo assets from future damage due to instability

Need for Project

- History of instability at the site
 - Movement observed via historical aerial imagery since at least 2002
 - 2008 NDDOT memo
 - Now beginning to impact roadway
- Provide a long-term solution to maintain safe, efficient travel on US Highway 10
- Prevent future damage to NDDOT and West Fargo utilities

Work Completed to Date

- Field Investigations
 - Topographic and Bathymetric Survey
 - Geotechnical Investigation
 - Wetland Delineation
 - Cultural Resources Survey
 - Pipe Televising
- River Hydraulic Evaluation
- Geotechnical Modeling/Design
- Development of Repair Concept
- Environmental Justice Analysis

Geotechnical Evaluation: FLAC Analysis with Piles






Figure 2 FoS plot for FLAC model with slightly more strengthened zones

- Temporary single lane closure – westbound right lane
- Temporary
 pedestrian detour
 to south side of
 Main Ave



Right-of-Way

- JEM Property
 Development II, LLC
- Operated as West Fargo Self Storage
- No buildings on portion proposed for acquisition

Total Estimated Project Cost: \$2.0 million

Benefits of Proposed Design Concept

Benefits

- Cost effectively stabilizes slope
- Minimizes river impact (small temporary impact for storm sewer repair)
- Minimizes tree removal
- Aesthetic (below grade)
- Minimizes operation and maintenance

Other Alternatives Considered

- Regrade to a Stable Slope
- Soldier Pile Wall
- Drilled Concrete Shafts
- Retaining Walls
